

(Joshua 11:15) Notice that part I put in bold: he left nothing undone. This was not his assessment. Neither was it the assessment of his peers. This is the observation that God made and recorded for us. Joshua s testimony was that of accomplishing everything that he was supposed to do. As we look at this thought of leaving nothing undone, I am not suggesting that you can do everything that you want to do or everything that others want you to do. I am saying that when you find...
