


Trading To Extinction

It is a shocking tale of cruelty, crime and human greed. This is an industry which, like the drugs trade, is fuelled by money, and whose tentacles encircle the world, from the remote forests of Asia to the trafficking hubs of Beijing, Bangkok, London, Tokyo and New York. A poacher who kills a rhino and removes its horn in India gets \$350. That same horn sells for \$1,000 in a nearby market town. By the time it reaches Hong Kong, Beijing or the Middle East, the horn is worth \$60,000 per kilogram, rivalling the street value of cocaine, and even the price of gold.
