Secondly, the author explores the notion of street pedagogy as a genuine and powerful professional tool. And thirdly, the book underscores what Zambrana-Ortiz calls the interconnection of the artscience within the political and biographical act of teaching . The purpose is to inform education teaching practice with the radical framework that, like the neurosciences, believes emotions to be a vital precursor to the planning of action, the process of decision-making and the broadening of our cognitive parameters. The chapters focus on different and yet complementary dimensions of a college teaching initiative boasting a unique interplay between a transgressive narrative, reinvented methodology and authentic samples of students contributions to the project.
