In 1893, the distinguished folklorist Andrew Lang re-edited the work. Lang s introduction to Kirk s extraordinary blend of science, religion, and superstition is included in this edition. For many years, The Secret Commonwealth was hard to find available, if at all, only in scholarly editions. Academicians as well as lovers of myths and legends will prize this authoritative but inexpensive edition.
