The Pugliese cucina povera, food of the poor , is renowned for its simplicity, ingenuity and deliciousness. A few simple ingredients and a few simple steps are all that are needed to create sublime, flavour-packed dishes. Even Puglia s famed pasta is made with just flour and water. Think orecchiette with broccoli rabe; ciceri e tria (tagliatelle with chickpeas); cavatelli with cherry tomatoes and rocket; carciofi fritti (fried artichokes); Gallipolistyle rigatoni with prawns; rice, potato and mussel tiella; fennel and potato bake; farro with beans, chickpeas and mussels; tomato and mozzarella panzerotti; braised oxtail with lentils; slow roasted goat with fried polenta; hazelnut and chocolate cake; and zeppole - sweet...
