The islands on the eastern side are Reushinski and a half dozen small islands westward of it, Linski Island, on which is Fort Novo Dvina, and Brevennik Island which continues the same coast line and is only separated from Linski by a narrow channel. The whole of the western side of this reach is occupied by the large Nikolski Island and a number of small ones lying off its northeastern side. The fourth reach takes a 132 direction for over 2 miles, and has on its northeastern side the southern part of Brevennik, on which are commercial wharves, factories, and sawmills. On the southwestern side of the passage is Ostrovskoi Island with several villages on it in one of which the pilots reside. Shoals extend 1 mile eastward of that island, and there are several islands to the eastward...
