Therefore, dictionaries are very important tools for non-native speakers who wish to learn English. English is a language that was influenced by many different languages over centuries, e. g. in the 5th and 6th century, when the Angles, Saxons and Jutes invaded Britain and brought their languages with them. Another influence was the invasion of Britain by William the Conqueror in 1066, which introduced kind of French to the English language. Accordingly, the vocabulary of the English language has only gotten larger over time, and has resulted in the increase in the number of synonym pairs (i. e. for many terms there are equivalents with different origins that frequently have slightly different meanings). This fact helps to explain the variety that one finds in current English and also explains why the English language often offers...
