It was found that there were several lines in this region which had no companions, and which could be used without hesitation. Close double lines were assumed to have positions depending upon the relative intensities of their components. The plates were measured with one of the measuring microscopes in use for the regular line of sight work. Each plate was measured with both violet left and violet right in the eye piece. A plate of the sky was taken with a very long slit and the amount of the curvature of the comparison lines was determined in the same manner as by Campbell.
