You will meet a philosopher whose job is to remind people of their mortality, a fifteen-year-old boy who has a fight with his father on Yom Kippur eve, a Chilean political refugee in New York whose only ambition is to have a bathroom of his own, a jumbo-sized salesman who sells through intimidation, an ultra-orthodox Jew who has built a wall between his religious and business practices, and many others.
