


Psychology a Short Account of the Human Mind

Psychology: a Short Account of the Human Mind is essentially an introduction to the study of psychology, and as such must be judged. It is a difficult matter to give a fair idea of what modern psychology is in such brief compass, but the author has performed his task well, on the whole. One feature of the book is much to be commended: it is not a mere catalogue of facts, or digest of the larger works on the subject, but a lucid exposition of the science from the author s point of view. The second chapter, General Conditions of Mental Development, gives in the briefest possible way some of the more significant facts of physiological psychology. It is necessarily somewhat scrappy, but perhaps worth the thirtyfive pages devoted to it. The rest of the book is devoted to the subjects usually treated in an elementary psychology. The order of the chapters is not fortunate. After the chapter on Sensation, come those on Laws of Mind, Memory, Reasoning, Perception, etc. This unnecessary separation of the treatment of...
