In 2011, global mobile data more than doubled for the fourth year in a row. The number of devices connected to mobile networks worldwide is around five billion today, and could rise to 50 billion by 2020. By that time, wireless technologies are expected to contribute \$4.5 trillion to the global economy through the expansion of existing business and the creation of new opportunities. This growth has created unprecedented demand for commercial access to wireless spectrum. At the same time, U.S. Federal spectrum needs are also rising. For example, the number of unmanned aerial systems (UAS) operated by the Department of Defense (DOD) has drastically increased from 167 to nearly 7500 from 2002 to 2010, and the systems...
