Though the proclamation bears date of the 14th day of February, 1783, it should be remembered that the pre liminaries were signed on the 20th Of January of that year. Washington announced the fact to his army on the 19th Of April. New York had been in British hands since September 15th, 1776. Fighting substantially ended with the battle Of Yorktown in October, 1781, its decisive nature compelling the British Virtually to admit their inability successfully to continue the struggle.
