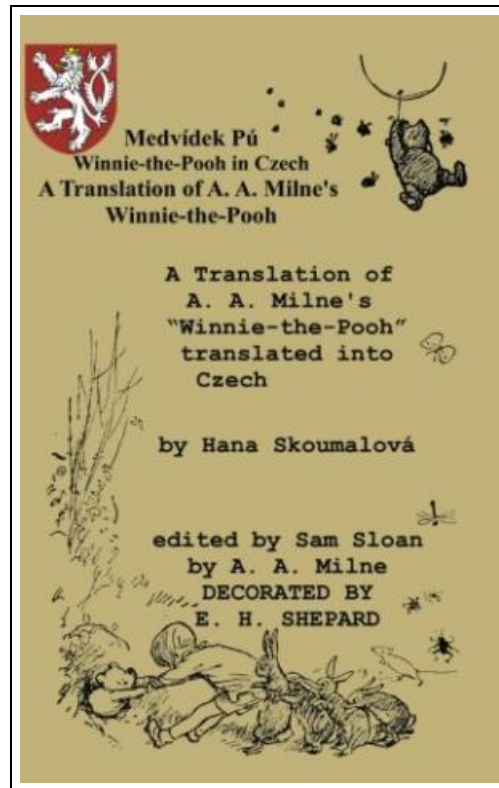

He was born on March 18, 1923 in the small town of BrandYs nad Orlicl in the Republic of Czechoslovakia. He died on December 5, 1984 in Prague.
