Nature s Magic, first published in 2003, presents a bold vision of the evolutionary process from the Big Bang to the 21st century. Corning refers to it as Holistic Darwinism. Among the many important insights that are provided by this new paradigm, Corning presents a scenario in which the human species invented itself; synergistic, behavioral and technological innovations were the pacemakers of our biological evolution. Synergy has also been the key to the evolution of complex modern societies, he concludes.
