


Report to Senator Inhofe on Tulsa Airport Authority s Management and Operations: Project Id: CC-2003-062 (Paperback)

Inhofe, chairman of the Committee on Environment and Public Works. We found instances where the Tulsa Airport Authority s procurements of professional services, which were funded by the Airport Improvement Program, did not adhere to FAA s required competitiveselection procedures. We also found conflicts of interest on the part of former authority officials, poor recordkeeping by the authority, and a lack of sufficient oversight by FAA, in addition to other issues. The report identifies areas we are continuing to investigate and includes the audit report sent to FAA.
