




An Automatic Intelligibility Test

Publisher/Verlag: VDM Verlag Dr. Müller | Based on the Post-Laryngectomy Telephone Test | In voice and speech therapy, there exist a lot of standardized and well proven tests for voice and speech assessment. However, these tests are usually performed by a single physician and the result is sometimes only "quality changed" or "quality unchanged". Furthermore, they are dependent on the physician's current state and mood, so the same test might yield different results if performed twice or by different physicians. A standardized automatic and objective test could provide a useful tool to support the diagnosis and treatment, and can aid the evaluation of different therapy methods. The Post-Laryngectomy Telephone Test (PLTT) is a standardized intelligibility test for patients with substitute voices who lost their natural voice due to a partial or total laryngectomy. This work introduces an automatic and objective version of the PLTT.
