SECTION VII PLANER AND SHAPER REPAIRING OLD PLANING MACHINES I Was given a free-hand in overhauling a dozen old planing machines which had been in service from ten to thirty years and made by various manufacturers. They ranged from 20 in. to 36 in., in size. I found the T-slots and stop-pinholes badly worn and after measuring both on all the machines, I decided to make them uniform in order to interchange stops, studs, bolts, angle, squaring plates, etc. Securely clamping an electric end milling attachment to the rail head having the largest T-slots I procured a cutter that would just clean up the bottom, top and sides of the lower portion of the T-slots, leaving the sides of the upper portion to be planed later. I then threaded a 1-in. rod a little longer than the longest table, drilled and tapped the...
