

Since the test was conducted according to grades, the papers were first classified by grades to find out if the curve of successes would correspond to that in the four detail test. As shown in Table I, the curve of successes is very irregular from the eighth grade through the special classes. This irregularity is caused by the difference in the number and composition of each grade. Ior instance, in some of the grades there is a large number of over-age retarded children, while other grades are comparatively free from them.
