The other alteration which I wish to see effected, is the omission of the words most religious, (most religious king) in the prayer for the Parliament, which looks too like flattery or servility. It was the intention of the commissioners for reviewing the Liturgy in 1689, to omit in the prayers this and the like expressions, and to use only the words our king, or our sovereign. It would, I think, be a material improvement in our church service, if some alterations were made in the...
