To this end, attention has now been paid to the plan of their embryonic development, and upon this side evidence has been obtained which, whether of major or minor importance in the study of descent, has at least the interest of newness. For to the embryologist Chimaeroids have until recently remained practically unknown, and they are thus the only vertebrate group of their anatomical importance-if ranked as a subclass-to have escaped investigation. On the other hand, from the standpoints of comparative anatomy and paleontology these shark-like fishes have received considerable notice, and they have figured in publications of the past half-century as the most primitive vertebrates, or, more precisely, as the least modified descendants of the ancestral cranium- and jaw-bearing vertebrate. And in such a role (which I now believe is only partially deserved) they have been given especial importance in problems...
