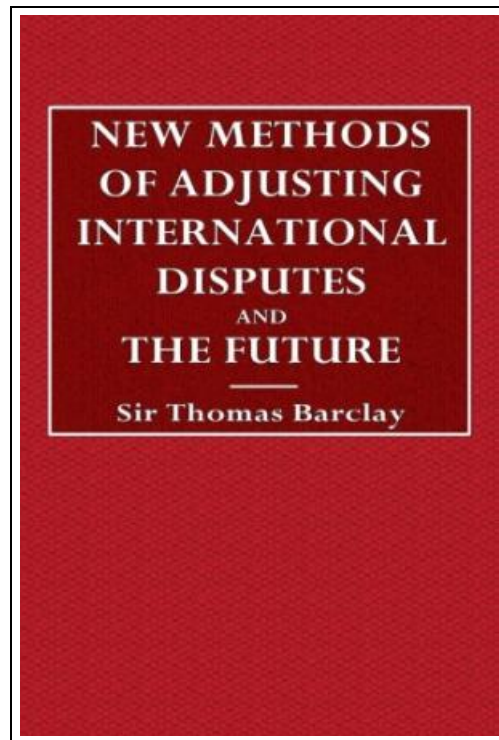

The present volume is intended to meet a want which has long been felt. There is no English book dealing with Arbitration and the other Pacific Methods of adjusting International disputes and differences as a part of the political system of nations, or endeavouring to determine the scope and limitations of these methods. In this volume an attempt is made to show in what respect they form part of the existing diplomatic machinery and the direction in which they are susceptible of development. Arbitration is frequently appealed to, on the one hand, and condemned, on the other, as if the last words for and against it were that it is, should be or cannot be a substitute for war. It will be seen in this volume that, without exaggerated expectations, arbitration and the other methods which have been co-ordinated by the Hague Conferences serve many purposes which narrow the area of international dissension. As regards the failure of peace methods in connection with the present war, the first suggestion of mediation, by a strange contrast to hei ultimate attitude, came from Germany. As Sir Edward Grey records in a dispatch to Berlin, the German ambassador had told him that it would be a very desirable thing if Russia could act as a mediator with regard to Serbia. Four days later, Sir Edward Grey suggested at Berlin that simultaneous and joint action by Germany, Italy, France and Great Britain at Vienna and Petersburg might have a mediating or moderating influence. Then, on July 28, Austria-Hungary declared war against Serbia. Even, in spite of this precipitation, efforts to arrive at an effective mediation were continued by...
