

This is in marked contrast with the results obtained by cutting out alternate plants in 1909, but perhaps the weather conditions were the most potent factor in keeping down the percentage of trash. The influence of variety may also be important in this connection, but this can only be determined by experiment. A note of explanation regarding quality as related to the last cutting of this test is demanded by the peculiar conditions obtaining at the time of harvesting, which occurred during a period of excessive rainfall.
