In order to give additional height and importance to the Facade when seen from Parliament Street, I propose to do away with the parapet which now divides the northern side of Trafalgar Square from the carriage road and foot pavement, and with the two flights of steps which ascend to them, and to substitute one broad flight of steps at least two thirds the breadth of the square. From all points from which the National Gallery would be seen to most advantage, the road would be concealed and the steps would appear to be the real approach to the building. This would, of course, add considerably to its apparent height and would give it grandeur and dignity. It must always be borne in mind that the National Gallery will be best seen from a distance as it occupies the culminating point of a long and gentle rise. Parliament Street will probably, in the course of time, assume a very different appearance from...
