The assembled drawings of the clock shown in Figs. 1 and 2, are the personal work of the whole Senior class of about 45 pupils, each one of whom had a particular part assigned to him; and after that part had been drawn in detail, it was put in its proper place in these drawings by the pupil who had made it, so that the assembled drawings are the composite work of the class....
