Later, the third objective is to choose a clever poem or short story that your child will enjoy reading. If this finally requires the funny papers or a comic book, that is your decision. Nevertheless, when parents make reading a meaningful for fun activity at home, there children have the greatest opportunity to become excellent readers. However, if you notice hearing or vision problems, or problems of dyslexia (spatial impairment) tell your child s homeroom teacher. SPM.
