I may be allowed, however, to call special attention-to the first and second of the papers composing the present volume. Our objection is that the terms of the present oath offer a gratuitous insult to the adherents of the ancient faith, as is powerfully brought out by Father Bridgett. In the short account of Blessed Thomas Percy, the recently beatified Earl of Northumberland, it is made clear that, contrary to what our ordinary History Books tell us, the Northern Rising in 1569 was not an act of treason against a lawful sovereign, but the resistance of northern Catholicism to the attempt to suppress it by persecution.
