This collection of copiable certificates provides an opportunity to celebrate every possible behaviour or personality characteristic we could think of. Many examples reward responsible behaviours towards other people and the environmentordinary things like showing a visitor around or caring for the plants. There are 196 key-copies, half A4 size and wire bound for easy use on the photocopier. An introduction on self-esteem and a pupil record sheet challenges the teacher to use one a day!.
