In Beverley, an old-established town, two new stores have been built and opened, the hotels rebuilt and enlarged, new building for the Bank of Western Australia, and enlargement of State school; also several private houses have been built on the suburban lots by people having businesses in Beverley, who go in for a little gardening and fruit cultivation in their leisure hours. At Kokeby, a store, school, and blacksmith's shop have been established, and several of the town blocks have been sold. Fruit trees do remarkably well in this townsite. At Brookton the progress has been most marked; a State school, church, good store,...
