

He was graduated from St. Francis Xavier College, New York City, July 1, 1867, and afterwards received the degree of A.M. from that institution. He was admitted to the bar in February, 1871, and practiced his profession more or less till his death. He served as district attorney of his district and as State senator, and was five times elected to Congress. He died February 10, 1896, and was buried in the Catholic cemetery near his home at Cuero, Tex., on the 14th of February following. The funeral services at the church were under the direction of Bishop Forest, who concluded with the following words: O Lord, have mercy on the Honorable William Henry Grain, the Catholic American Congressman.
