Most people would not practice contraception, if they do not achieve their preference, which in a way may become an impediment to the National policy on population for sustainable development. The book has captured how the rural Hausa community expressed their preference for either having a son or a daughter, with preference for boys taking higher lead, then preference for sex mix is expressed after achieving main sex preference.
