He was a very little boy when his fathers family made the long and arduous journey across the plains and mountains, arriving in Salt Lake City in the fall of 1847 with the second company of pioneers. In the spring of 1849 the family continued on to California, where his parents conducted an eating house near Auburn in the mining district. Here he earned considerable money, for a lad, by running errands and caring for the horses of travelers. At the age of eleven he began to formulate his plans and seek an education. On the 29th of December, 1856, at Rio Puta, in Yolo county, California, he was baptized a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints...
