


Crash Course: One Year to Become a Great Leader of a Great Company

Crash Course takes a different approach. The heart of the book is 52 short essays, one for each week of the year, that you can read while you are having your cereal on Monday morning and put into practice that same day. Crash Course also has stories illustrating what Bernie Bulkin has learned through life experiences - jury service in a gang murder case, buying a first house, travelling to the Soviet Union, learning to ride a horse - and how you can do likewise. This is a book of successes and failures, good and bad leaders, skills that need to be learned and practised, as well as how to build a great career and a great company. There are lessons to help leaders at all levels, from frontline managers in their first leadership role to CEOs in companies both large and small....
